What is the enrollment and payment process?

Who will be facilitating the program and supervising the children?

The program will be facilitated by qualified staffs that make children feel comfortable in their surroundings. Young adults and adults are trained prior to the program on the lvy League philosophy, with each one having the natural ability to connect with children and act as positive role model. A complete background checks are completed on each employee.

How will the Ivy League program differ from other programs?

The staff will be taking an active participatory role with the children in the program. The staff will be proactively facilitating activities in a structured camp program. Will my child have someone to help with schoolwork?

YES! Internet access will be available for the students. Laptops are to be brought from home for class instruction and meeting with teachers. If a child needs help completing or understanding their work, the staff will help clarify lessons and help them finish their assignments. If any issues arise we encourage open communication with our staff. Staff will collect log in information and teacher meeting schedule prior to first day.

Can I enroll in Ivy League After School Program if Manalapan-Englishtown does not provide transportation to Ivy League for afterschool care?

Yes, Ivy League provides transportation in a school vehicle driven by a CDL driver to Ivy League for aftercare from Lafayette Mills and Wemrock Brook Schools. We do not provide transportation to Lafayette and Wemrock for before care at this time.

What procedures will Ivy League have in place due to Covid-19 Pandemic?

Staff and students will be screened for symptoms and fever prior to entering our building from home and school. Additional cleanings and sanitation of classrooms will be maintained by staff. Staff will wear masks 100% of the time. Students will be encouraged to wear masks when feasible.
